We've been busy with a number of projects commemorating the centenary of Bradford City's 1911 FA Cup triumph:

- publication of **GLORIOUS 1911** by David Pendleton
- showing of archive film from 1911 at Pictureville, Bradford
- organising a dinner to celebrate the anniversary at the Midland Hotel, on April 26 2011, one hundred years to the day since the victorious team returned to Bradford.

Also we've been heavily involved in the exhibition **When the FA Cup Came Home** at Bradford Industrial Museum. In order to raise funds for a revamp of **bantampast** as well as for the Bradford Burns Unit we've sold a range of replica historic enamel badges including a number to mark the centenary of the FA Cup victory itself. A presentation of £5,000 to the Burns Unit is being made at the 1911 Centenary dinner in April, 2011. Our next objective will be to help raise money to support the club's youth team budget.

This leaflet provides further details of our activities including news of our next publication, **PARADERS: The History of Valley Parade, 1886-2011**, to mark the 125th anniversary of Valley Parade being first used as a sports venue in September, 1886. You can also find details of the **PARADERS** range of heritage City badges based on authentic historical designs and reproductions of the club's earlier crests.

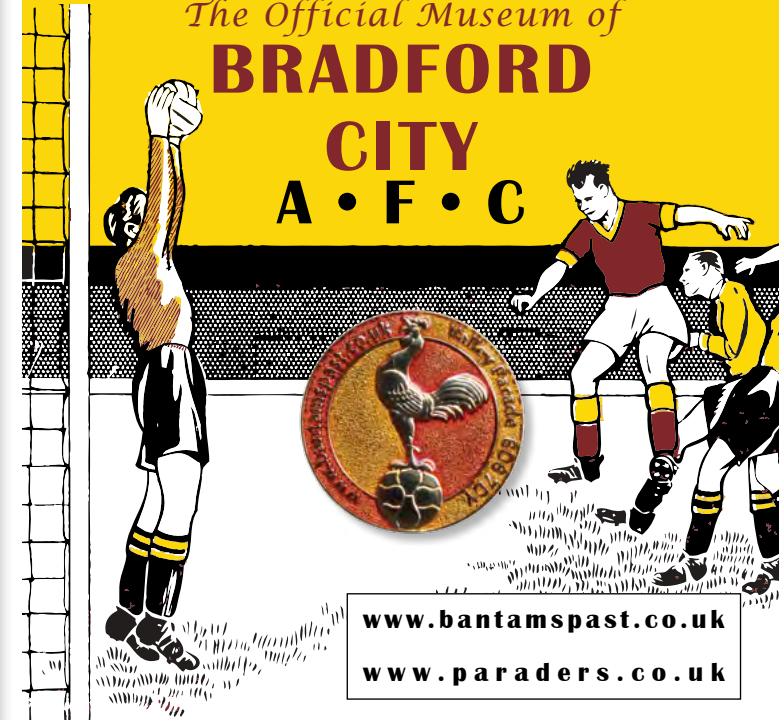

Manningham RFC originally adopted the Bradford shield. The Bradford coat of arms that was granted to the city on 31 December 1907 was then used by Bradford City AFC until 1966. Chairman Stafford Heiginbotham retained the civic identity in his boar's head and shield in 1966 and then again in 1985.
